**"MURALI"**  
spinning around  
the globe

Alston Koch, who was born in Sri Lanka and now very much a part of the Australian music scene, has attracted worldwide interest with his tribute song to the world's greatest bowler in the history of cricket, Muttiah Muralidaran.

The record is spinning on turntables in most parts of the world, especially Down Under and in the Asian region. It was even spoken about on the BBC's Test Match Special.

'Murali' was officially released on Creative Vibes Records and iTunes worldwide on the first day of the recently concluded One-day Internationals in Australia.

And since it happens to be the spin wizard's last trip Down Under as a cricketer, the tribute song was very much in the news, both on radio and on TV, in that part of the world.

The song was heard at the Melbourne Cricket Grounds, while Sri Lanka was battling Australia, and also on radio station 3AW, as a farewell tribute to Murali.

Denis Walter, interviewing the song's writer and performer, Alston Koch, played excerpts of the song quite a few times and

wished Murali well.

"Disco Lady", the first Gold disc and hit song, written and performed by Alston Koch, was played on the network just before the "Murali" song.

"Murali" was also played and had a good rap on ABC's "Grandstand Cricket" with Damian Fleming and Harsha Boshle when they discussed the

song and the past of Alston Koch. ABC "Drivetime" referred to 'Murali' as the tropical song of the decade.

It's already being aired on radio in Jamaica and will be released in the West Indies this month to coincide with the Sri Lankan tour of the islands.

'Murali' is the only tribute

song officially endorsed by Murali himself.

A music video, too, has been released to go with the song and reports indicate it's on high rotation on MTV (Asia).

Being interviewed on Channel 9 at the end of the cricket, Muralidaran confirmed that it was his last trip to Australia.

Sheru also indicated to us that there is a possibility of her rejoining Aquarius who are now performing in Doha.

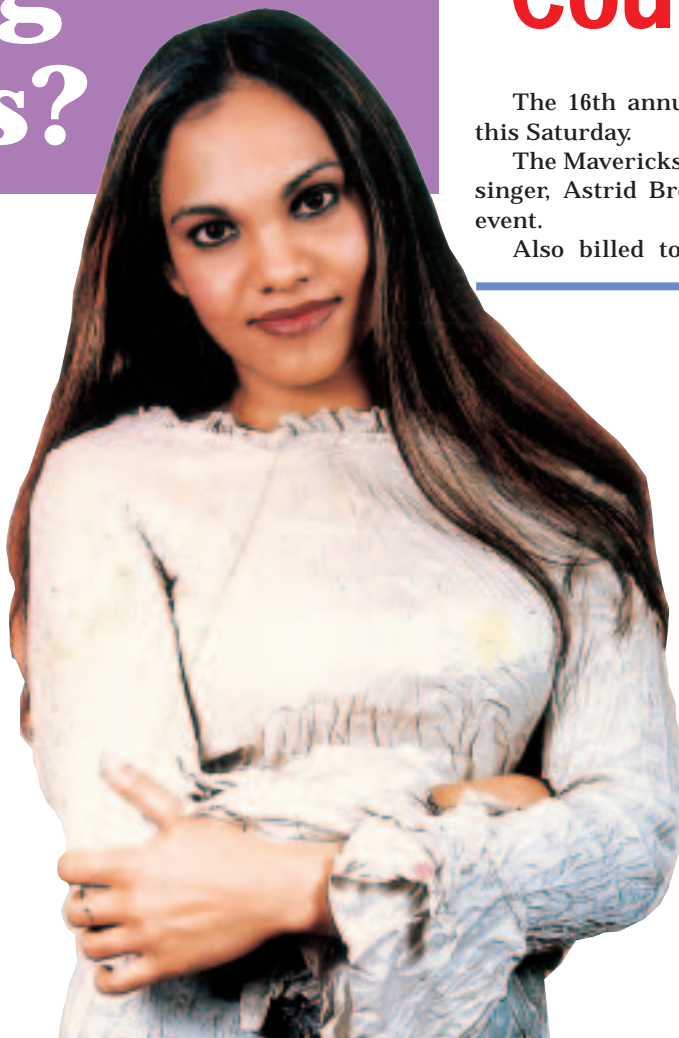
The band has switched to the disco scene again and Sheru's presence is bound to add glamour and also vocal quality to the Qube night club at the Ramada Hotel in Doha.

Friends of the singer have also claimed that the 24-year old begged one of her pals to smuggle some drugs into rehab on the first night of her two-week stay.

She apparently managed to stay off the drugs for 10 days in her attempt to gain a visa for the Grammys earlier last month. That failed and she has since then spiralled back down to the desperate level she was at before - mixing cocaine, ecstasy, cannabis and alcohol in a bid to dull the pain of her husband Blake's jail stint and looming trial.

Amy's pals, who fear for her sanity said, "It terrifies us."
