The guys spent hours and days rehearsing and it has certainly paid rich dividends because the initial trial contract of three months has been extended.

The band will be completing nine months at the Elrancho nightclub this September and then would be home for Ramadan. They go back a month later.

The new - look Damage comprises Janaka Vithanage (formerly of Summerset) who is the leader of the band and lead vocalist. He also plays lead, bass and keyboards.

Janaka covers hits by Toto, Bon Jovi and Maroon 5. Kamal Karunathilake (ex-Spark and Zodiac) tackles bass, lead, keyboards, vocals and the sax as well. He handles songs

by the Bee Gees and Sean Kingston. Rasika Prasad is the group's lead guitarist. He is capable of playing nearly 15 instruments but prefers to pay extra attention to handling the

keyboards, bass and drums. He's good at doing songs of Chris Rea and Michael Buble.

Hasitha Samarakoon (ex-Dreamteam and Spark) plays drums for the group. They say he excels in the art of rapping, and does songs of Snoop Dogg and Shaggy to perfection.

Ashan Fernando (ex-Aquarius), is on keyboards and sings R 'n' B and hip hop songs and is the Robbie Williams in the band.

Dhennis, the female vocalist from the Philippines and ex-member of Mirage, performs the hits of Mary J. Blidge, Jordin Sparks and Celine Dion.

Damage is now well equipped and cover a variety of music - from the '70s to the '90s, including reggae, rock, R 'n' B, hip hop and the very latest U.K. and U.S. chart hits.

Ashantha is a happy guy and says he owes his gratitude to Sohan of the X' Periments and also to Mr. Renhil Krishnan.

"Sohan guided and extended his support to me, when some musicians tried to demoralize the band members during the initial stages."

Carey has two Moonmen from MTV Japan, for the International Video Icon Award in 2005 and for the Video Vanguard Award in 2008. But in America, she's Susan Lucci - a perpetual nominee, but never a winner. She's hoping this year

Moonman, and I would say 'Touch My Body' deserves one. Brett Ratner directed it, I have a unicorn in there, I have [Guitar Hero] in there - who else has that?"

Even if she doesn't win, she'd be happy just to attend. "I haven't really gone, I've only performed," Carey pointed out, noting that she appeared in 1998 with Whitney Houston and again in 2005 to perform via satellite from Miami. And despite Carey's commitment to perform just two days earlier in New York at Fashion Rocks, "I will make it this year" to the Los Angeles ceremony on September 7, she promised.
